Note:-

(i)

In case the Duty Magistrate proceeds on planned casual leave during court hours of any working day, or proceeds on leave on any Sunday or holiday or after court hours, he/she shall make an alternate arrangement for duty work in his/her absence and obtain consent of the officer in writing under intimation to the undersigned.

- (ii) In case any officer on duty happens to proceed on leave due to some "emergency", then the duty work shall be attended by the next Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) In case any Judicial Magistrate proceeds on official training, the next Duty Magistrate in the duty roaster shall be the Duty Magistrate and the Magistrate concerned will inform the next Duty Magistrate about the same under intimation to the undersigned.
- (iv) The Affidavits of the witnesses (deposing before Sessions Court), shall be attested by the Duty Magistrate.
- (v) In case CJM/ACJM happen to be engaged in any official meeting or protocol duty, remand work pertaining to their Court, shall be performed by the Duty Magistrate.
- (vi) The period of duty shall commence from the Court hours i.e. 10 A.M. not from midnight.
